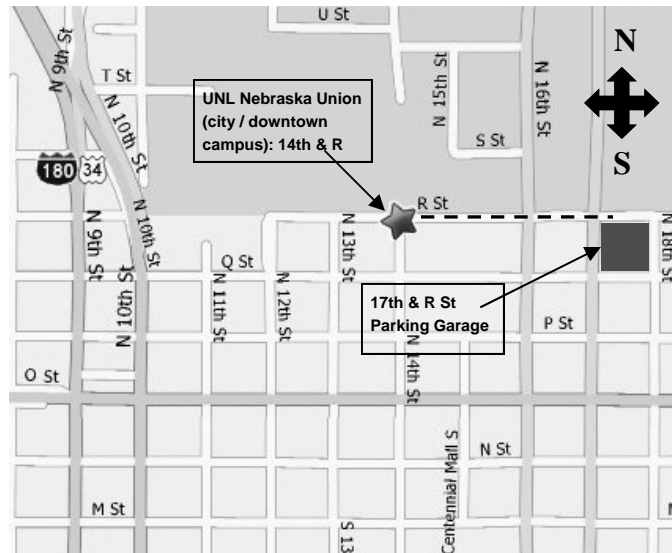
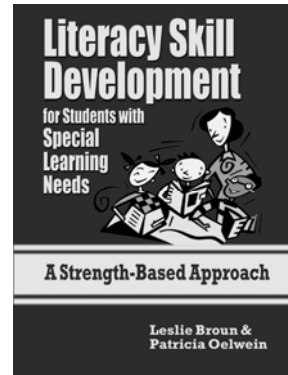

- Pioneering author who developed an internationally recognized reading program (used in 15 countries) for children with special needs that can be used to effectively meet a child's unique learning needs and style
- Her unique reading program has been successfully "field tested" on thousands of children with moderate to severe disabilities, including Down syndrome and autism
- Served as a teacher, an outreach trainer, and program coordinator at the Center on Human Development and Disability, University of Washington from 1992-1997
- An international consultant, lecturer, and program developer for parents and teachers (currently developing an Birth-21 program in Saudi Arabia)
- Promotes a wonderful “Teaching versus Testing” philosophy

“Instead of setting goals for vertical growth (higher reading levels), [we should set] goals for horizontal growth. The student’s success in reading is measured by how it benefits him in building competencies and independence, which will result in improving his quality of life, self-confidence, and self-esteem.”
